The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to transfer the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.97 dated 04.10.2020, registered at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 427, 294, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, to any independent agency i.e. Central Bureau of Investigation, Crime Branch etc.

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Dalwinder Singh, submits that the challan was presented on 24.11.2021 against seven accused; that three persons have been declared innocent; that four vehicles were recovered in the present case; that one vehicle is lying in Police Station Longowal, and that one vehicle is yet to be recovered.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
