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In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.5,00,000/-(Rupees Five Lacs Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellants in full and final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs Only) favouring the appellants with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of two weeks from today. The said amount shall be shared by the appellants in the ratio of 70% (appellant No.1) and 30% (appellants No.2 to 4 in equal shares) as has already been awarded by the learned MACT. In case of non-compliance, the appellants shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on their respective share from the date of order till the date of realization. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
