This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take appropriate action on complaints dated 21.06.2020 and 10.08.2020 (Annexures P/3 and P/4) moved by the petitioner to the respondents for lodging FIR with regard to committing cyber fraud with petitioner and his company.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already moved complaint on 10.08.2020 to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib (wrongly mentioned as Mandi Gobindgarh), copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, to look into and dispose of complaint dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P/4), in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within two months positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
