The matter is taken up through the medium of video conferencing.

A consent form has been received from the office of Mr. Ashwani Arora, Advocate dated 07.12.2021, whereby both the parties have agreed for full and final settlement with the enhanced compensation at Rs.1,75,000/- (Rupees One lakh seventy five thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the learned MACT, Chandigarh i.e. Rs.5,07,160/-.

The amount of compensation so enhanced shall be disbursed to the claimants as awarded by the MACT, Chandigarh within a period of four weeks from today. The claimants have undertaken to provide the bank details within 02 weeks enabling the respondent-Insurance Company to credit the amount through RTGS.

In case the appellants/claimants fail to provide the bank details for the purpose of transfer of amount so enhanced here-in-above, the insurance company will be at liberty to issue demand draft against the said amount.

It is further made clear that in case the insurance company fails to deposit the amount of enhanced compensation within the stipulated period of four weeks, it shall carry interest @9% per annum from the date it became due till the date of its realization.

The present appeal is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

A copy of this order be supplied to the respective counsel for the parties and file be returned to the High Court.
