Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 621 dated 09.10.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 186, 224, 307, 332, 353, 379 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 225 and 114 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are ladies and petitioner No. 1 is 72 years of age. They have been involved primarily because they are related to main accused Sarjeet Singh. It is alleged that when the police party went to arrest Sarjeet Singh, his family members and others had attacked the police party. Co-accused Ashok is alleged to have hit a brick on the head of the SHO. No specific injuries are attributed to the petitioners. They do not have any criminal antecedents.

This Court, by the order dated 03.11.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to

the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Dharambir, states that although the petitioners have joined investigation but they are not disclosing whereabouts of co-accused.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 03.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
