1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.322, dated 17.08.2020, registered under Section 61, Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15.12.2020, the petitioner joined investigation on 28.12.2020, fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail, no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab on instructions from HC Jagroop Singh, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15.12.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail, that no recovery is to be effected

5. In view of the statement of the learned Addl. AG, Punjab, order dated 15.12.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
