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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

In view of the order dated 18.11.2021 passed by this Court on the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have agreed to go in for conciliation and arbitration afresh.

Learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from Mr. Rakesh Kumar Kansal, Member Secretary, District Level Micro Small Enterprises Facilitation Council-cum-General Manager, District Industries Centre, Ludhiana, also submits that the authorities too have no objection if the parties approach them for conciliation and arbitration again.

In view of the conjoint prayer made before this Court and the consensus arrived at between the parties, the petition is disposed of directing the parties to approach the concerned authorities, who shall undertake the conciliation and arbitration proceedings in accordance with law. However, it is agreed and is also made clear that parties shall have the liberty to raise all the possible/conceivable objections and issues before the authorities concerned.
