The matter is taken up in the Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat through video conferencing.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.2 lakh (Rs.Two Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is ordered to be paid to the appellant as full and final settlement of his claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a demand draft for Rs.2 lakh, over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, in the name of the appellant, in the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall accrue on this amount till payment from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue a proper receipt to learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company, after receipt of the said demand draft. The appellant/his counsel may collect the demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

However, the recovery rights given to the Insurance Company,

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vide award dated 05.02.2014 passed by the learned Tribunal, shall remain intact.

Copy of the order be supplied to the parties and their counsel and the file be returned to the High Court.
