Allegedly respondent No.6 has cheated the petitioner who is an aged lady. She has got an FIR registered against him and trial is in progress. Meanwhile, respondent No.6 has got his passport renewed in which the spelling of his surname has been changed, thus, the petitioner has approached the passport authorities for impounding the passport of respondent No.6 but no action has been taken. Thus, legal notice dated 23.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) has been issued but without any effect.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 & 2 only.

Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to seek a reply from the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 23.09.2021 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
