Motor Accident Claims Tribunal has awarded an amount of Rs.1,00,000/-. Both the parties have settled the issue of enhancement. Insurance Company is ready to enhance amount of compensation of Rs.1,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal. The proposal given by the Insurance Company is accepted by the appellant and the appellant is ready to receive the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- inclusive of interest component.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due date till final realisation of the amount. On receiving the cheque

from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
