The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of certiorari/mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and grant the benefit of previous pensionable service rendered by the petitioner with Accountant General (A&E) Haryana towards qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits; to grant the benefits along with interest @ 18% p.a.; as well as to decide the representation dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-16).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P16) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
