The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.8.2020, vide which, direction was issued to release the pension and other benefits to the petitioner within 90 days.

It is not disputed that the order has been finally complied with but learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is aggrieved with the fact that the respondents were required to pass appropriate order within 90 days i.e. by 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 but when no order was passed by that date, the petitioner sent a notice on 10.12.2020 and they passed the order on 11.12.2020. This shows that the respondents want to harass the petitioner unnecessarily.

Be that as it may, as on date the order stands complied with.

In view of the same, no useful purpose would be served to proceed with the present contempt petition. Dismissed accordingly.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the said order in accordance with law.
