The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count work charge service period along with regular service for the purpose of pensionary benefits in terms of orders (Annexures P2 to P4) and in view of instructions dated 18.04.2016 issued by the Govt. of Punjab; to pay the entire arrears to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% p.a.; as well as to decide the representation dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the representation dated

04.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
