The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.387 dated 29.09.2010, registered under Sections 323 & 376 IPC at Police Station Hansi, Sadar, District Hisar.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner committed the offence punishable under Section 376 IPC. He snatched chimta of the complainant and hit the same near ears of the

complainant and also gave blow on the right thigh. Thereafter the petitioner took the lady in the fields and committed the offence. The FIR was registered on 29.09.2010. Petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar vide order dated 26.07.2012. Petitioner was arrested only on 11.07.2020. Petitioner remained proclaimed offender for about 8 years. The affidavit executed by one Rajpal in the context of his being not a witness is immaterial at this stage.

No ground is made out to grant indulgence in the favour of the petitioner. Petition stands dismissed. However, the trial Court shall make every endeavour to conclude the trial at the earliest.
