The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to restore the rate at which the family pension was being paid to the petitioner till May 2021 as well as to decide her representation dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-3).

At this stage Mr. Raminder Singh Joon, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of Mr. H.S. Batth, Advocate and accepts notice for the respondents.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 08.09.2021

(Annexure P-3) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
