The grievance of the petitioner is that despite order of restoration of a demolished watercourse passing through the land of respondents No.3 & 4, he has given the land on long lease to respondent No.5 for setting up a retail outlet.

At the very outset, Mr. Ashish Kapoor, Advocate appearing for respondent No.1 by virtue of advance notice having been served states that respondent No.5 has been found ineligible vide letter dated 17.09.2021 and thus, the petitioner has no grievance at this stage.

In view of the above statement, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
