The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.96 dated 24.06.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been implicated on the basis of the alleged CCTV footage which indicated that he was present at the place of occurrence but no injury is attributed to him.

This Court, by order dated 16.12.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Ram Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation and the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
