Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent no. 1 to consider and decide the revision petition pending before it for more than three years.

Keeping in view the prayer made, Sh. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana was requested to take instructions in the pre-lunch session.

In the post lunch session, Sh. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana, on instructions from Sh.Harish, Registrar, Office of Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Haryana, has stated that the revision petition could not be decided because the record of the authorities below was not traceable. He informed that already directions have been issued to re-construct the record within one week. He further submits that learned counsel for the petitioner may be requested to assist the respondent in re-constructing the record. He also submits that the revision petition shall

be disposed of within a month thereafter.

Learned counsel for the writ petitioner states that the petitioner would co-operate with the authorities in re-construction of the record.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.1 to positively decide the revision petition within a period of 1 ½ month from today with whatever record is available after re-construction thereof.
