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Present appeal has been filed by the claimant under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short 'Act') against the impugned Award dated 17.02.2014, passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sangrur (for short 'Tribunal') for enhancement of compensation on account of death of Nirbhai Singh (for short 'deceased').

Today, the matter has been listed before the Lok Adalat. Learned Counsel for respondent No.3/Insurance Company, on instructions, has offered an amount of 4,00,000/- (Four Lacs Only) over and above the compensation awarded by learned Tribunal, which is acceptable to the appellant/claimant as full and final settlement. In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No.3/Insurance Company to deposit the aforesaid enhanced amount by way of cheque or demand draft in the name of the appellant with the Office of Lok Adalat of this Court within six weeks from today and the same be released in her favour against proper receipt and identification. In case there is a failure by

respondent No.3, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization. The terms and conditions of disbursal of the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation will remain unaltered, as passed by learned Tribunal.

FAO stands disposed off.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Insurance Company for further action.
