The petitioner has been arrayed as an accused in the case bearing FIR No. 73 dated 06.10.2019, under Sections 363/366-A of IPC (Sections 376-D/323 IPC and Sections 5/6 of POCSO Act added later on), at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala and in terms of order dated 24.08.2020, he has been declared as proclaimed person.

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the prosecutrix has not supported the prosecution version during the course of trial against the co-accused.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the learned trial Court and move an application for bail. He has only restricted his prayer to the extent that the bail application that may be submitted by him be disposed of expeditiously.
