LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in CM-3005-CII of 2021 is for preponement of hearing of the main appeal i.e., FAO No.5220 of 2014 from 27.07.2021 and for disposal thereof in terms of the compromise arrived at between applicant-respondent no.2- Insurance Company and the non-applicant-appellants.

It is submitted that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties.

Learned counsel for the appellant-claimants affirms and verifies the factum of settlement between the parties. Affidavit dated 19.03.2021, of the appellants Anita and Des Raj in respect to the settlement are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

At request of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of the matter is preponed from 27.07.2021 for today itself.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant-claimants seeking

enhancement of compensation awarded to them by the learned MACT, Palwal, vide award dated 02.12.2013, on account of death of Manisha, in a motor vehicle accident. Sum of Rs. 2,67,000/- has been awarded by the learned Tribunal.

It is submitted that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the appellant-claimants and respondent no.2- Insurance Company. Appellants have agreed to accept a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by learned tribunal, Palwal vide impugned award dated 02.12.2013 as full and final settlement of their claim and the same shall be deposited before the learned tribunal within three weeks from today.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above CM No. 3005-CII of 2021, is allowed and FAO No. 5220 of 2014 is disposed of in terms of the settlement arrived at between the appellant-claimants and respondent-Insurance Company. Needless to say, amount of Rs.4,50,000/- be deposited by the respondent-Insurance Company before the learned tribunal within three weeks from today and the same be disbursed to the claimants *qua* adequate proof of identity. Copy of this order be conveyed to the appellant-claimants at the given address. Liberty is afforded to the appellants to move appropriate application in case the amount is not received by them or there is any factual inaccuracy in the facts projected before this Court today.
