This is an application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for exemption from filing of certified copies of Annexures P-1 to P-4.

Application is allowed. The same are taken on record.

CRM-M-42692-2020

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.561 dated 23.11.2020, under Section 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 & Section 3 & 4 Dowry Prohibition Act, registered at Police Station Fatehabad, District Fatehabad. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of

the Court to the order dated 23.02.2021, whereby, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No. 561, dated 23.11.2020, under Section 420 IPC and Section 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, registered at Police Station Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the complainant have apprised this Court that compromise has indeed been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that though a substantial amount has been paid by the petitioners to the complainant, however, the remaining amount of Rs.13,60,000/- shall be paid to the complainant within the next couple of days as conveyed to him by the petitioner. Hence, a request has been made for a short adjournment so as to do the needful.

List on 20.05.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Ravinder does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.02.2021 is made absolute.
