The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.125 dated 05.07.2020, registered under Sections 148/149/427/341/120-B/506 IPC (Sections 188/307 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 deleted later) at Police Station Bilaspur, district Yamuna Nagar.

As per the FIR in question, on 03.07.2020, after stopping the complainant-Kulbir Singh's car, the petitioners and their co-accused threatened the complainant that in case he wanted to run his liquor vend in the area he would have to pay them a weekly amount. On the complainant's refusal, he was abused and his car was damaged. Thereafter in the night the petitioners and their co-accused fired at the complainant's liquor vend .

As per the status report filed by the State, investigations have revealed that in fact it was the complainant who, with the object of falsely implicating the petitioners and their co-accused fired on the closed shutter of his own liquor vend and in this regard FIR No.276 dated 19.11.2020, under Sections 182/211/195/285/120-B IPC and Sections 27/30 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Bilaspur, has been registered against the complainant-Kulbir

Singh. The status report further goes on to state that since the petitioners and their co-accused having been found innocent applications for their discharge are being filed before the Trial Court.

In view of the above, subject to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail.
