The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.409 dated 21.05.2019, registered under Sections 379-B & 506 IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal (later on offence under Section 392 IPC was deleted).

Allegations against the petitioner are of snatching gold as well silver jewellery, cash amount and mobile phone etc. on the point of pistol and weapons from the residential house of the

complainant. The accused tied the mouth of the complainant as well as her servant with clothes. Recoveries of countrymade pistol, currency notes of Rs.6 lakhs, gold and silver ornaments and ladies purse have been made from the petitioner. The aforesaid recoveries have been effected on the basis of disclosure statement of the petitioner himself. Complainant has also identified the petitioner. Co-accused remained unsuccessful in getting the bail as CRM-M No.12792 of 2020 was got dismissed as withdrawn by him on 03.06.2020.

In view of aforesaid facts as pointed out by learned State counsel, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioner for the grant of regular bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
