This is a 2nd petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 23.02.2021 registered under Sections 376, 420 IPC at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

The petitioner herein had approached this Hon'ble Court vide CRM-M No.18438 of 2021 and the matter was argued for some time, however, realizing the fact that this Court was not inclined to grant relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 10.08.2021.

In the 2nd petition, counsel for the petitioner has not been able to bring forth any changed circumstance or raise any argument on the basis of which concession of anticipatory may be granted to petitioner except the

contentions raised in the first bail application, which have already been discarded by this Court and the same was dismissed as withdrawn.

Consequently, this Court does not find any ground to grant relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and therefore, instant petition stands dismissed.
