The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.339 dated 24.09.2021 registered under Section 323, 325, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the complainant has filed his power of attorney through special messenger which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Naresh Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.11.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
