The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 16.03.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 17.12.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sanjeev Kumar, states that the petitioner has deposited two Bank Drafts separately drawn in the name of both the complainants to the Investigating Officer. He upon instructions further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

However, the drafts be given to both the complainants within a period of one week from the date of communication of the order.
