Petitioner has approached this Court praying for granting 6 weeks emergency parole under Section 3(aa) read with Section (b) & (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962, for looking after and meeting with his mother on medical grounds and also to perform his marriage and further for quashing the impugned order dated 06.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Moga, denying the petitioner the benefit of parole.

On notice having been issued, reply has been filed by the respondents wherein reference has been made to an earlier order dated 12.03.2020 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CRWP-463-2020 which was preferred by the petitioner seeking the same benefit of grant of parole for 6 weeks. The plea which has been taken in the present writ

petition was duly considered by the Division Bench of this Court but did not find favour with the bench leading to the dismissal of the said writ petition.

In the light of the fact that the present writ petition has been filed on the same grounds on which an earlier criminal writ petition preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed, we do not find any ground to interfere in the impugned order challenged in the writ petition. The same stands, therefore, dismissed.
