The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

Quashing of FIR No. 691 dated 6.6.2017 registered under Sections 34, 312, 323, 406, 498 A, 506 IPC at Police Station Panipat City, Panipat and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 17.12.2020, parties were directed to appear before trial Court concerned for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.
