By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, in Complaint case no.1742/2017, dated 09.09.2017, instituted under Section 138/142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, read with Section 420 of the IPC, titled as Punjab National Bank v. Hardeep Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner having noted a wrong date as the date on which he was to appear before the trial court, he may be admitted to bail again, he already having been admitted to bail earlier.

Notice of motion is issued only to the respondent State, with Mr. Neeraj Poswal, learned AAG, Haryana accepting notice, on the asking of the court.

He points to the detailed order passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Ambala, dated 22.10.2021, wherein the number of dates given on

which the petitioner had sought exemption from personal appearance and thereafter still did not appear, leading to cancellation of the bail granted to him on two occasions, with him having again thereafter surrendered, and thereafter, yet again not having come present before the trial court.

In view of the above, the excuse given on behalf of the petitioner today, is not at all acceptable.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
