Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed, *inter alia*, for issuance of direction to the respondents to appoint the petitioner on compassionate ground as per policy dated 21.11.2002 (P-7).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, confines his prayer only to the extent that his representation dated 21.09.2021 (P-6) be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off

with direction to respondent No.3, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 21.09.2021 (P-6), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is made clear that in case, respondent No.3 is not the competent authority, the representation be forwarded to the concerned quarter within one week of receipt of certified copy for compliance of this order.
