The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the respondents to take action against the persons in wrongful possession of the vehicle on the basis of complaints dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) and dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-2).

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that complaints dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) and dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.
