Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0169 dated 27.08.2020 under Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 17.12.2020: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that Lovepreet Singh @ Labba and petitioner are selling illegal arms, a raid was conducted and co-accused Lovepreet Singh @ Labba was arrested and two pistols of .32 bore were recovered from him.

Learned counsel further submits that later on, the disclosure of the aforesaid co-accused was recorded, wherein he stated that source of weapon is known to petitioner and thereafter the petitioner was involved in the present FIR...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.12.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
