Learned counsels appearing on behalf of the respective parties submit that the parties have settled their dispute and according to the said settlement, the appellant-claimant will be paid a sum of Rs.4,25,000/- (Rupees Four Lac Twenty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala, vide impugned award dated 13.09.2012. In support of the claim, the statement of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the claimant has been submitted before the Court.

As per the settlement, the amount of Rs.4,25,000/- is to be paid to the appellant-claimant within a period of four weeks from today, failing which, the appellant-claimant will also be entitled for interest @ 9% per annum starting from today.

As the parties have already settled their dispute, the present appeal is disposed of with the direction that keeping in view the agreement between the parties, another sum of Rs.4,25,000/-, over and above the amount already awarded by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Patiala, be released in favour of the appellant-claimant within a

period of four weeks from today, failing which, the appellant-claimant will be entitled for interest on the amount of Rs.4,25,000/- @ 9% per annum starting from today.
