Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Manpreet Kaur aged about 20 years is now residing with her mother, i.e., Paramjit Kaur-petitioner, of her free will and consent. To this effect, Manpreet Kaur had already made statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur., He prays that accordingly, this habeas corpus petition should be disposed of having become infructuous.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, also endorsed the above said fact regarding recording of the statement of Manpreet Kaur by Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur. He further submits that Manpreet Kaur is presently residing with her mother Paramjit Kaur of her own. In these circumstances, this writ in the nature of habeas corpus filed by petitioner-Paramjit Kaur for release of detainee (her daughter Manpreet Kaur) has been rendered infructuous. Accordingly, this petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.
