In this petition, the petitioners, who are accused persons in FIR No.79, dated 26.04.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 452, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of FIR with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, including Challan (Annexure P-5) on the basis of compromise.

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide Compromise Deed (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, vide report dated 03.02.2021 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Respondent Nos.2 to 4, who are complainant and victim/injured, are represented by their Counsel who does not dispute the factum of compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 have themselves compromised the dispute with the accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.79, dated 26.04.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 452, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom including Challan (Annexure P-5), are hereby quashed *qua* the present petitioners.
