The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 433 dated 07.08.2021, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 201 IPC and Section 66 of the I.T. Act, 2000, were added later on), registered at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only allegation against the petitioner is that the answer key of the Haryana Police Recruitment paper was sent from the mobile phone of co-accused Ramesh Kumar to the petitioner. He also contends that there is no *prima facie* material to connect the petitioner with the alleged commission of offence.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that the answer key was sent to him on his mobile phone. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner would be necessary to examine the role of the petitioner and other accused.

Therefore, I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed here-in-above shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.
