The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 28.05.2021, under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 201, 420, 468, 471, 120-B and 34 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had purchased a stolen motorcycle. He has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused.

This Court, by the order dated 09.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
