ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 129 dated 06.08.2021, under Sections 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that co-accused Vinod Sharma, who is the husband of the petitioner, and the petitioner had taken a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- on the pretext of getting the FIR against the complainant cancelled. He, however, contends that the petitioner has been involved because she is the wife of the co-accused. She is not involved in any other criminal case. He also contends that co-accused Rupinder Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order dated 13.10.2021 passed in CRM-M No. 36582 of 2021.

This Court, by the order dated 09.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jagmohan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
