Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On request, adjourned to 05.01.2021.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Ravinderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub division Chamkaur Sahib, District Roopnagar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the dispute between the parties has been settled and he has instructions to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
