This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 331, dated 07.10.2020 under Sections 396, 201, 193, 194, 195, 203, 211, 419, 420, 435, 302, 120-B, 212 of IPC and Section 3(2)(v) (va) of the Scheduled Caste @ Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989, registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hansi.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the accused had conspired to claim insurance amount showing death of Ram Mehar. Ramlu along with the car was burnt. The allegation against the petitioner is that she was one of the conspirator.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 11.10.2020. No active role has been attributed to the petitioner. The investigation is complete. He further submits that the co-accused has already been granted bail in CRM-M-7068 of 2021 decided on 17.09.2021 by this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail. He submits that petitioner was main conspirator along with other accused. He submits that there are thirteen prosecution witnesses out of which four have been examined. He further submits that recovery of Rs.4,10,000/- was made from the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the nature of allegations and the fact that investigation is complete, conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds/ heavy surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
