LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner i.e. The NCC Employees Welfare Organisation seeks direction to the respondents to revise and grant pay scale of Rs.5200-20200 + Rs.1900.00 (GP) to its members as recommended by the Pay Anomalies Commission headed by Sh. G. Madhavan w.e.f. 01.01.2006. It is submitted that members of the petitioner – Society are employees working against the post of LASCARS in the State of Haryana. They are in Class C group but are drawing pay scale meant for Class D. Grievance of the petitioner was placed before the Madhavan Commission, which has recommended revision of pay scale of members of the petitioner – Society. It is further submitted that Finance Department on 18.06.2018 has approved recommendations of the Madhavan Commission. Approval for amending service rules is also stated to have been afforded by the Chief Minister, Haryana on 06.03.2019, however no action, it is submitted, is being taken by the official respondents. Detailed representation as well as legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P9) has been served but to no

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a decision on legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P9), submitted by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of writ petition stands supplied. Learned counsel for the respondents does not raise serious objection to the restricted prayer.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 19.07.2021 (Annexure P9) by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
