The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondent/Corporation to release 100% family pension w.e.f. hear date of entitlement i.e. 08.11.2015 along with all consequential benefits and interest @ 18% p.a.; as well as to decide the legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in

accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
