1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking direction to respondent No.2 to conduct fair investigation in the representation dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) given by the petitioners.

2. It is contended that the petitioners have given a representation (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 and 3 on the allegations of physical abuse and harassment by the accused persons. It is further submitted that a rent agreement of shop has been executed between petitioners and accused and now petitioners are being threatened by the accused to vacate the shop without giving prior notice to vacate it.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Shashank Bhandari, APP, UT, Chandigarh, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will

take a decision on the representation of the petitioners.

5. In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 25.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
