Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.12, dated 05.02.2020, having been registered at Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 324, 148, 149 of the IPC (with Sections 325 and 326 of the IPC added later).

Pursuant to the order dated 23.12.2020, learned State counsel submits, on instructions from ASI Dharampal, that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
