The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 274 dated 16.11.2020, registered under Sections 324, 341, 452, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohan Lal submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required. State counsel further submits that both the petitioners are not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above fact, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 16.12.2020 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
