This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

On 18.12.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 6 as they have entered into marriage on 08.10.2020 against their wishes.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Haryana through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 05.01.2021. ”

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Pooja Vashisth, IPS, Asst. Superintendent of Police, Samalkha,

District Panipat on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, wherein it is mentioned

that the petitioners are not facing any threat. Their statements are also appended with the status report as Annexures R-1 and R-2.

In view of above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed off as such.
