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**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.126 dated 31.05.2019 registered under Sections 328, 380, 120-B IPC at P.S. Lehra, District Sangrur.

On 27.04.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

*"The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.*

*Notice of motion was issued on 18.12.2020 after noticing the fact that there was no MLR conducted in respect of allegations of administering poison by the*

*petitioner in the tea of her husband. The ornaments belonged to the petitioner herself. The availability of cash amount of Rs.2 lakhs that too on an unattended table was claimed to be farce.*

*On 10.02.2021, after hearing learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mansa. As per report of the Nodal Officer, Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mansa, the mediation remained unsuccessful. The matter has been sent back to the High Court.*

*Adjourned to 20.07.2021.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 01.05.2021 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of her arrest, she shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to her furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

*Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion in the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on the merits on the adjourned date.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 29.05.2021 to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 27.04.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
