Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed, *inter alia*, for issuance of direction to the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Principal from the post of Lecturer with all consequential benefits with effect from the date his juniors were promoted.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, instead of pressing the petition on merits, confines his prayer that legal notice dated 03.09.2021 (P-2) be decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 03.09.2021 (P-2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
