The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to issue a proper pension payment order clearly regulating the basic disability pension of the petitioner at a minimum rate of ₹ 18,000/- and to release the said benefits along with interest and costs, with a further prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside letter dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P8); as well as to decide the representation dated 21.08.2021 (Annexure P-9).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the respondents to consider the representation dated 21.08.2021 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
